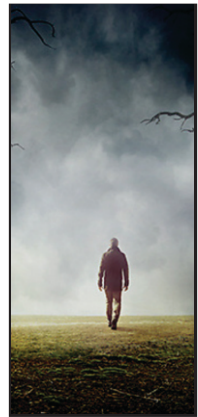

“This past month most of the country has opened back up with limited restrictions. The government has also announced that next month they will remove the outdoor mask mandate. We thank the Lord for His provision during Covid and the growth we have seen in the lives of the church members...”

We are continuing to translate and teach the discipleship material. It has been challenging my Thai language abilities. However, even though I might not be as clear as I would like to be, I do believe the lessons have been very helpful to the new Christians in our church...

New Life Bible Institute has been moving forward and we continue to develop the classes and overall program. It was also exciting to be able to have another graduation at New Life Bible Institute. Khun Mon has been studying for six years now and she is excited to begin helping in the Bible Institute...

Pastor Gowit has had the opportunity to travel to another village about 40 minutes away from Nong Phur. He has been having a Saturday service and is praying about being able to start a church there. This past week they had a new believer follow in baptism... On July 25th we will travel to Udon Thani for a revival service with Pastor Gowit... Many people will be traveling to attend these services... Thank you for your support and involvement in the work here in Thailand.

We are always asking the Lord for wisdom as we continue to follow His leading in the ministry here. We would ask that you pray as we begin the process to switch our visa to a religious visa. We are praying that we can accomplish this switch at the beginning of next year. We are grateful for your continued prayer and support.”
