

Since the beginning of May, we have focused on knocking on the doors of our neighborhood on Saturday mornings. At first, we didn't see any



dozens of people). However, as of the past month, we have been seeing first-time visitors with greater frequency. One of these visitors is a lady named Jenifer. She has been coming to the services over the past six weeks with her daughter Marjory (seven years old). Please pray that the Lord's Word would bring the hidden things to light and that Jenifer and Marjory would be saved if they haven't been. Over the couple of months, we have seen the Lord work in Evelin's life. Evelin and her husband Carlos have been attending, sporadically, our church services for the past several years. Their two children (Carlos and Sara) have been learning a great deal of Bible, from Christine, in Sunday school. Evelin grew up in a Christian home, but her husband is unsaved. I've had the chance to sit down and witness to him. Though he listens intently to what I say, he has not yet responded to God's call for salvation. Thankfully, we are seeing God working. Please pray for her spiritual growth, and the salvation of Carlos, Carlitos, and Sara. As with any other church, there are members who are going through serious trials. We have previously asked for prayer for Rina and her sons (Luis, David, Miguel, and Gabriel). She has been coming to church faithfully with Miguel and Gabriel. About six months ago, Rina's husband Juan was taken to jail for a serious crime. He is awaiting trial, and we suspect it will be a very long time before he is liberated. Please pray that Juan would be saved in jail and that Rina would learn to trust more fully in the Lord. We took Rosa to college last week and have already returned to our work in El Salvador. It was a very quick trip to help her get settled in Virginia. While it was difficult to leave her in a place so far from us, we know that it is God's will for her life. We are pleased that she is seeking to honor God with her life and education. Pray for us as we make this adjustment to life without our daughter here with us. Pray for her as she makes the adjustment to life in the United States. Thank you for praying for our ministry and our family.
